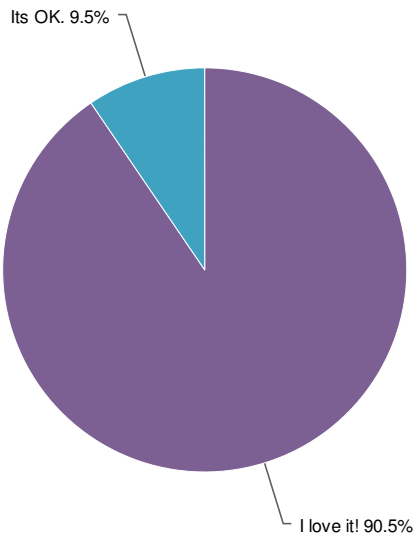


New Summary Report - 02 June 2016

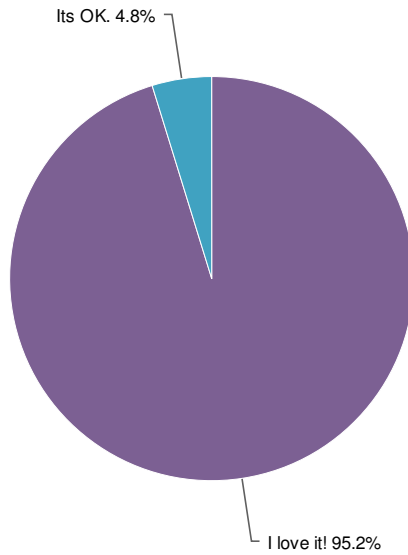
1. Install widened trail connection between the two parts of Taney Ave-Explain

Count	Response
1	Better for strollers
1	Good plan but lower priority for me, if things get cut.
1	The current grassy area between the two parts of Taney is a local hang-out for drinking and drugs. There is consistently broken liquor bottles and trash along the path. While the widening of the trail (and secondary park entry) will provide more visibility. There really needs to be (1) motion detection lights (possible cameras (real or fake)); and (2) park/community watch signs to discourage this type of behavior so close to the playground. In fact, leaving the May 26th site meeting with my wife and 8 month old son we encountered a man smoking marijuana at 6:30pm on a Thursday--emphasizing the need for more visibility in this area.
1	Maybe one day Taney Avenue can be reconnected for all traffic. But at least with an improved trail, bicycle traffic will be accommodated.
1	This will provide a nice connection to Early Street and on to Wheeler Avenue or the Holmes Run Trail. Bollards should not be the automatic solution to limit vehicle traffic. If bollards must be installed, they should be safe and visible and properly marked. In addition, bollard placement should allow for users on recumbent bikes, tandems, bikes with trailers and double-wide strollers. Black bollard which are the default bollard for Parks in Alexandria are not visible in the dark.

Count Response

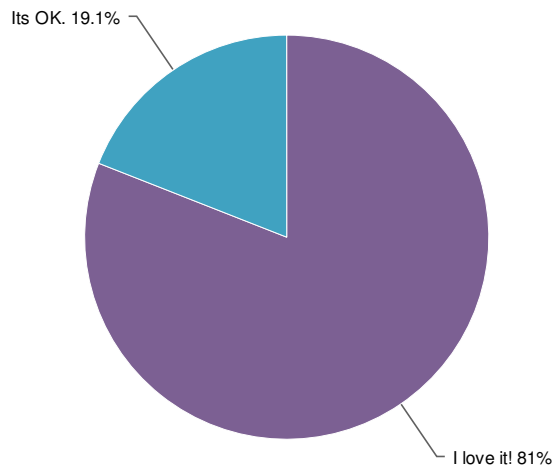

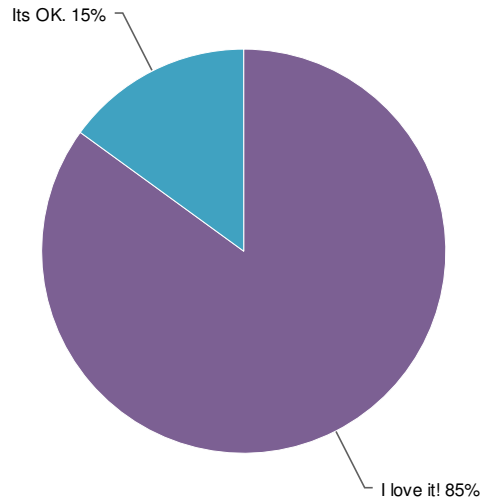

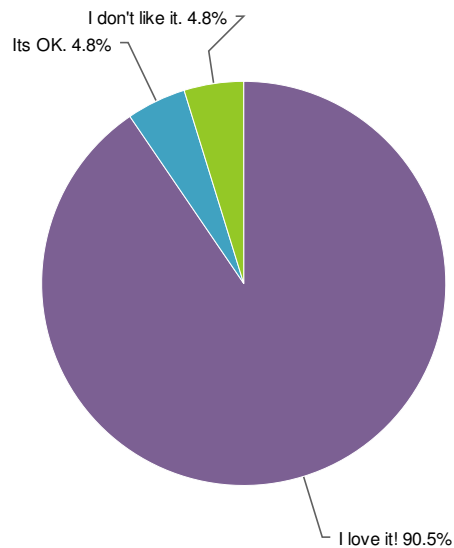

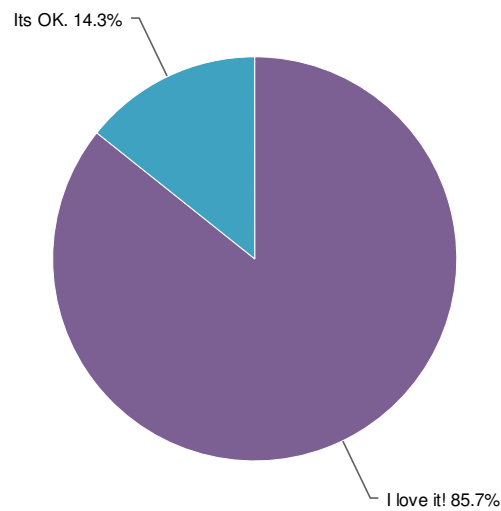

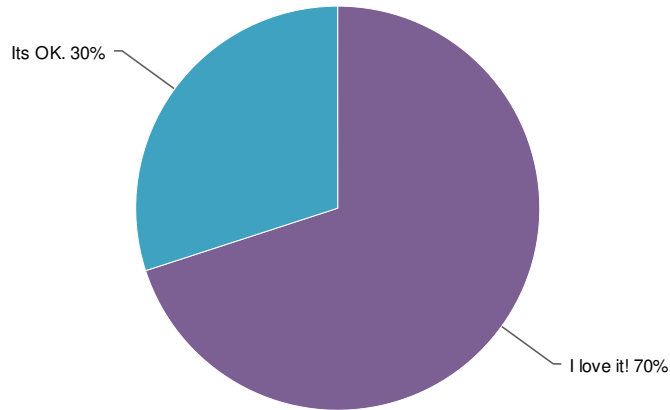

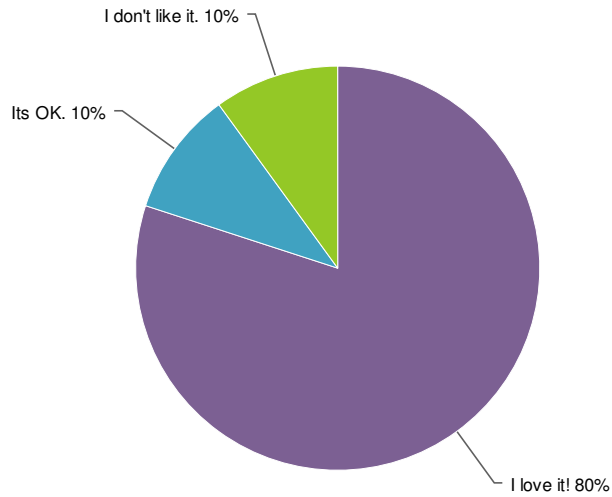

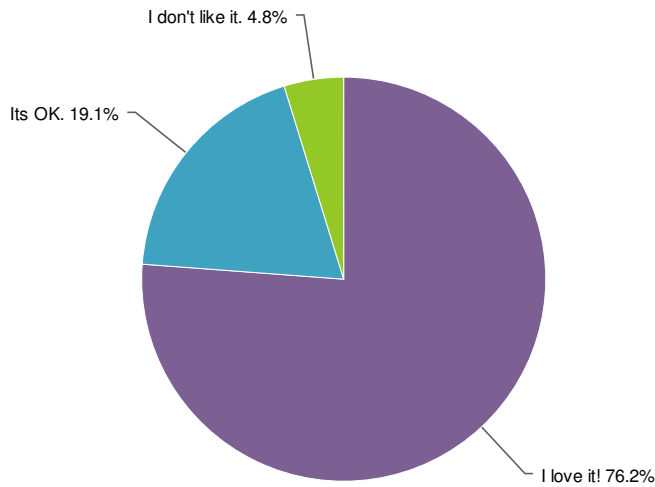

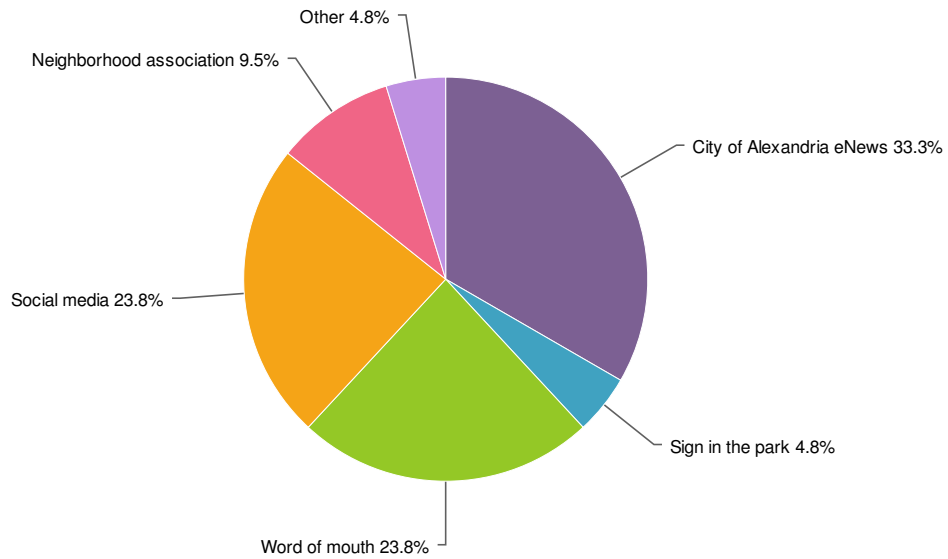

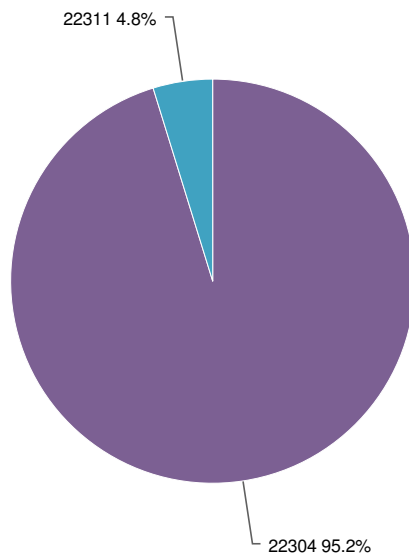
